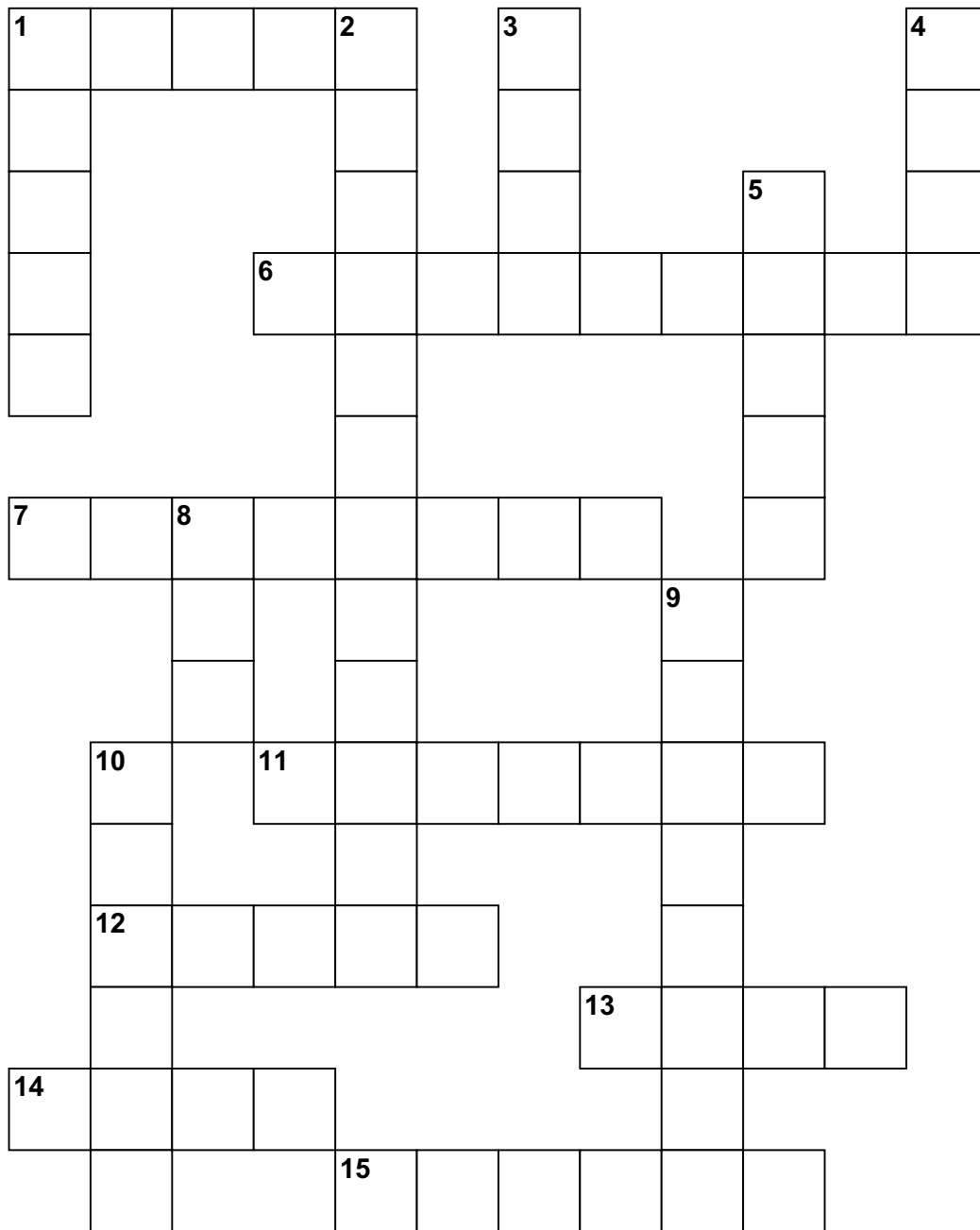

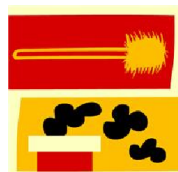
CHIMNEY FIRE SAFETY

- 1 Device used to provide heat for cooking or warmth
- 6 Brick or stone space in a room for making fires

- 11 Structure above a fireplace that carries smoke to the outside

- 13 Hard tree material burned for fuel
- 14 Form of energy, or the state of being very warm
